



WHERE SLITRIG MEETS TEVIOT IN HAWICK

Through the auspices of the Hawick 1514 Club a full-colour limited edition of the above oil painting by Adam Robson is on offer. The original work hangs in St. Margaret's Home in Hawick and was commissioned through a legacy from Annie Jackson, a long term, "weel-kent" and popular resident.

Hanging in the Health Centre is an earlier painting of Hawick by the same artist. The print of the painting was sold-out in a limited print run of 350, with proceeds benefiting many deserving causes, as noted overleaf.

In view of the popularity of the first limited edition, the 1514 Club, in association with Adam Robson, has decided to make available 400 reproductions of this second painting. Each print will be signed and numbered by the artist and the image will measure approximately 350x475mm (13 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 18 $\frac{3}{4}$ ") [overall card size 450x640mm (17 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 25 $\frac{1}{4}$ ")]. It will be on offer unframed at a price of £38 (plus £2.50 p&p).

It is again intended by Hawick 1514 Club that appropriate bodies will benefit directly and it is hoped that this second initiative will receive widespread support from all who appreciate an historic scene known to generations of Terries.
